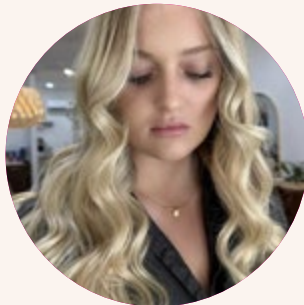

EXPERT Q&A

Tenille on Low-Tox Haircare & Sustainability



Why did you decide to create a low-tox salon?






For years, I worked as a **colourist educator**, travelling the world and doing hair at the highest level. I was passionate about my craft, but I started feeling **exhausted, unwell, and constantly burnt out**. At first, I thought it was due to the high-stress environment, long hours, and travel demands. But it wasn't until I gave birth to my first child that I realised something was seriously wrong.

When I delivered my baby, **my placenta was completely black**. My doctor immediately asked if I was a **heavy smoker** – but I wasn't. We quickly realised it was due to the **chemicals and toxins** I had been exposed to every day in my work as a hairdresser and it was **chemical poisoning**.

Hairdressers are actually **three times more susceptible to cancer** than those in any other industries due to daily exposure to harsh chemicals in hair colour and salon products. That was my wake-up call. I knew I had to make a change – not just for myself, but for my team and our clients. That's why I started Little Birdie Hair Co, as a space where we could deliver amazing hair results while reducing exposure to toxic ingredients.

What are the biggest toxins in traditional salons that we avoid?

Some of the most harmful chemicals found in traditional hair products include:

-  **Ammonia & Ethanolamine (MEA)**
Linked to respiratory issues and scalp irritation.
-  **P-Phenylenediamine (PPD)**
A known allergen that can cause severe reactions and dermatitis.
-  **Lead Acetate**
Found in some hair dyes and linked to neurological and reproductive harm.
-  **Resorcinol**
Disrupts hormones and is a skin irritant.
-  **Heavy Metals**
Can be absorbed through the scalp and contribute to toxicity in the body.

We've worked hard to remove these from our salon while still achieving **high-performance, long-lasting colour and styling results**.

How do you ensure clients still get high-quality results without harsh chemicals?

By thoroughly researching **every** brand and product before we bring them into the salon. We analyse their **ingredient lists, sourcing practices, and sustainability efforts**. It's not just about hair colour – it extends to **styling products, shampoos, treatments, and even our cleaning products**. If it isn't green, we don't use it.

What can clients do at home to make their routine more eco-friendly?

It starts with awareness. Think about not only what you're putting in your body, but also what you're putting on your body. Here are some easy swaps:

Check the ingredients

Choose low-tox, eco-conscious hair products that are free from harsh sulphates, parabens, and synthetic fragrances.

Think about packaging

Look for brands that use recycled, refillable, or biodegradable packaging.

Buy quality over quantity

Invest in salon-grade products that work better and last longer.

Embrace sustainable styling

Swap plastic brushes for bamboo, use silk pillowcases to reduce frizz and breakage, and try heatless curls to cut down on heat styling damage.

Claire Goldsworthy:

Leading the Change in Sustainable Fashion

For years, Claire Goldsworthy has been at the forefront of Australia's sustainable fashion movement. As the founder of The Fashion Advocate, she has transformed the way consumers and brands think about ethical and eco-friendly fashion. Claire's journey is one of passion, persistence, and purpose, proving that fashion can be a force for good.

The Spark Behind the Mission

Claire's love for fashion has always been rooted in creativity and self-expression, but her passion for sustainability was sparked by frustration. "When I started digging into the industry's impact, I was shocked. The waste, the exploitation, the environmental damage – that's not what fashion should be about," she says.

Determined to make a difference, Claire launched her own circular fashion label, using only upcycled, vintage, or repurposed materials. But she knew change needed to happen on a bigger scale. That's when The Fashion Advocate was born – a platform designed to bring together like-minded sustainable designers, making it easier for consumers to shop ethically. Challenges in the Industry

While Shifting an industry built on overconsumption and profit over people hasn't been easy. "One of the biggest challenges has been shifting mindsets," Claire explains. "We've been conditioned to think that fashion should be cheap, fast, and disposable."

Changing that narrative takes time, persistence, and education – not just for consumers, but for brands, supply chains, and policymakers.

Running a purpose-driven business also comes with its own obstacles – scalability, fighting greenwashing, and proving that ethical fashion isn't just a passing trend. "There are moments of doubt, times when it feels like I'm shouting into the void," Claire admits.

" Every time I see an ethical brand make a sale or hear from someone who's changed their shopping habits, I'm reminded of why I do this. "





How to Make Sustainable Choices

For those looking to make more sustainable fashion choices, Claire's advice is simple: buy less, but buy better. "Sustainability doesn't have to be overwhelming or expensive – it starts with slowing down and being more intentional," she says.

"Before buying something, ask yourself: Do I really love this? Will I wear it long-term? Who made it?"

She also encourages embracing second-hand fashion – whether it's vintage shopping, thrifted finds, or swapping with friends. Choosing natural, biodegradable fabrics over synthetic materials is another easy but impactful shift.



The Power of Circular Fashion

Long before it became a buzzword, Claire was championing circular fashion – designing clothes with longevity in mind and keeping them in circulation rather than contributing to landfill. “Instead of churning out endless new products, circular fashion focuses on repairing, reusing, and regenerating materials,” she explains.

The traditional take-make-waste model of fashion is one of the most wasteful industries on the planet, but Claire believes circular fashion is a game-changer. Brands embracing circularity are designing for durability, offering take-back programs, and encouraging customers to extend the life of their garments.

“It’s not just about sustainability it’s about rethinking the entire system so fashion has a future.”

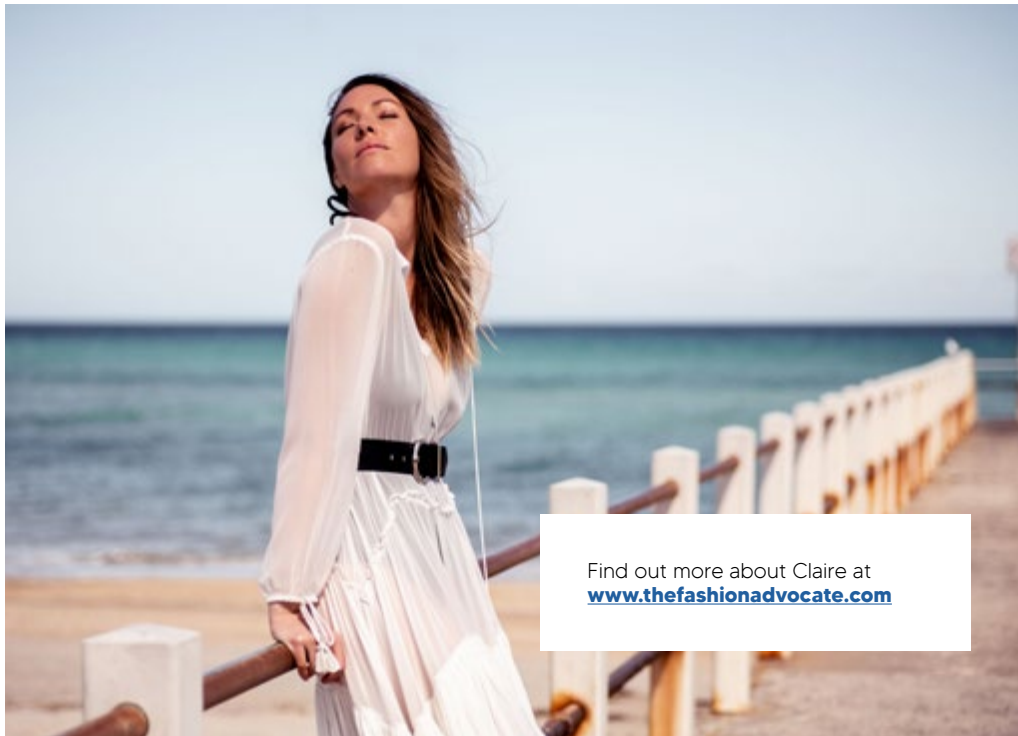
The Future of Fashion

While fast fashion still dominates, Claire is optimistic about the growing shift towards conscious shopping.

“For sustainability to become the norm, we need a complete mindset shift from brands, consumers, and policymakers.”

Greater transparency, ethical sourcing, and government policies that hold fast fashion accountable will all play a role in driving change.

Ultimately, Claire believes that consumers hold the greatest power. “The more we demand ethical and sustainable fashion, the faster brands will adapt,” she says. “We’re already seeing this – second-hand fashion is booming, big brands are being called out for greenwashing, and slow fashion is gaining momentum.”

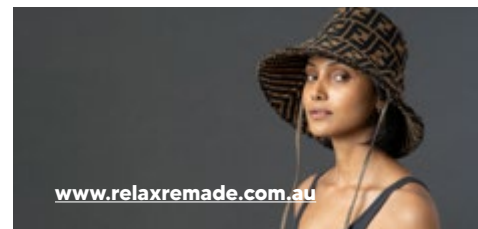
